Applications must be submitted EXACTLY as prescribed, and must include all the following (use this list to check off items as you complete them): A completed 2023 Youth Scholarship Application Form. Prior year or incomplete Application Forms will not be accepted. Evidence that the Applicant is an enrolled member of an NWIHA Voting Member tribe, such as written documentation of tribal enrollment by the tribal enrollment officer. Two current (dated less than 60 days prior to application date) reference letters signed by persons not related to the Applicant or the Applicant's family. Unsigned or outdated letters are unacceptable. Documentation that the Applicant will be 24 years of age or younger as of the application deadline date (March 31, 2023), such as a copy of the Applicant's tribal identification, birth certificate, or driver's license that shows the Applicant's birthdate. Evidence that the Applicant is, or will be, eligible for a higher education program during the program year. This may include transcripts from the school the Applicant is currently attending, or if not currently in school, a copy of the Applicant's high school diploma or GED. A letter of admission from the school is also acceptable. Each application must include an essay of 500 words or less, describing how the funds will be used and the Applicant's educational goals. Save the Essay Document and submit with the Application Form. All application materials must be in the form of scanned images, PDFs, or the like, and attached to

Applications received after this deadline will be rejected not be considered.

The decision to award a scholarship will be determined at least in part on the applicant's following the submission instructions EXCACTLY as described. Youth Scholarship Program Other Information

- 1. **Application by Previous Award Winners**: Only those previous awardees who are currently enrolled in a program of higher education (not high school) will be considered for another award for this program year.
- 2. **Notification of Receipt**: The NWIHA will send a reply to all applicants when an Application has been received. The notification will <u>not</u> provide any information as to whether the application is complete or not since it is up to the Applicant to make this determination prior to submission.
- 3. **Missing, Unreadable, or Incomplete Documents**: Applicants will <u>not</u> be contacted if the Application received has missing, unreadable, or otherwise unacceptable documentation, such as unsigned letters. An important criteria for granting scholarship awards is the responsiveness of the Applicant as demonstrated by the completeness and accuracy of the Application Form and the submission of the required documentation.
- 4. **Award Notification**: All applicants, successful or not, will be notified via email of the NWIHA Executive Committee decision. Scholarship awards will also be announced at the Spring Meeting April 18, 2023.
- 5. Successful Applications: Following the application deadline, successful applicants will be required to provide the name and address of the school where the funds are to be sent. Eligible educational institutions shall include accredited universities, graduate schools, community colleges, and trade schools. Award Payments (estimated at \$1,000 depending on funds available and number of successful applicants) will be made directly to the school, not to the Applicant or their family. Awarded scholarships will expire if the school information is not provided on or before December 31, 2023.
